WHEREAS, On the 15 day of Sept 2004, the time heretofore fixed for view of the proposed improvement, we, the Board of County Commissioners having jurisdiction in said matter, went upon the line of said proposed improvement and made personal view of the proposed route and termini thereof, and after full investigation and due consideration of all the facts and conditions pertaining thereto; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That we do find and consider said improvement of sufficient public importance to instruct the County Engineer to make an accurate survey and plat of the same, and furnish an accurate and detailed description of the proposed improvement describing the center line and right of way lines thereof.

WHEREAS, This day this matter came on to be heard on the report, survey, plat and detailed and accurate description as filed by the County Engineer, and said report having been read in open session, the Board proceeded with the hearing of testimony bearing upon the necessity of the said improvement for the public convenience or welfare and offered either for or against going forward with the proposed improvement by interested persons; and

WHEREAS, Said Board has considered said report and all the testimony offered, and all the facts and conditions pertaining to said matter; therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That said Board of County Commissioners do find said improvement will serve the public convenience and welfare; and be it further RESOLVED and determined to proceed with said improvement only upon the condition that the compensation and damages or such part thereof as this Board may deem reasonable and just be paid by the landowners owning lands within the vicinity who will be benefited by the improvement. On failure of such benefited landowners to pay such compensation and damages as may be adjudged against them by the day of 19, it is hereby determined that said proposed improvement be abandoned. It is further ordered that there be included in this order and made a part hereof the accompanying schedule setting forth the names if such benefited landowners, a pertinent description of such land and a statement of the amount of such compensation and damages to be paid by the owner, or owners, of each parcel of such land; and be it further

RESOLVED and determined to proceed with said improvement only upon the condition that the compensation and damages or such part thereof as this Board may deem reasonable and just be paid by the landowners owning lands within the vicinity who will be benefited by the improvement, and the balance, if any, be paid out of the County Treasury, it being the opinion of this Board of County Commissioners that the improvement is not of sufficient importance to cause all compensation and damages to be paid from the County Treasury. On failure of such benefited landowners to pay such compensation and damages as may be adjudged against them by the day of 19, it is hereby determined that said proposed improvement be abandoned. 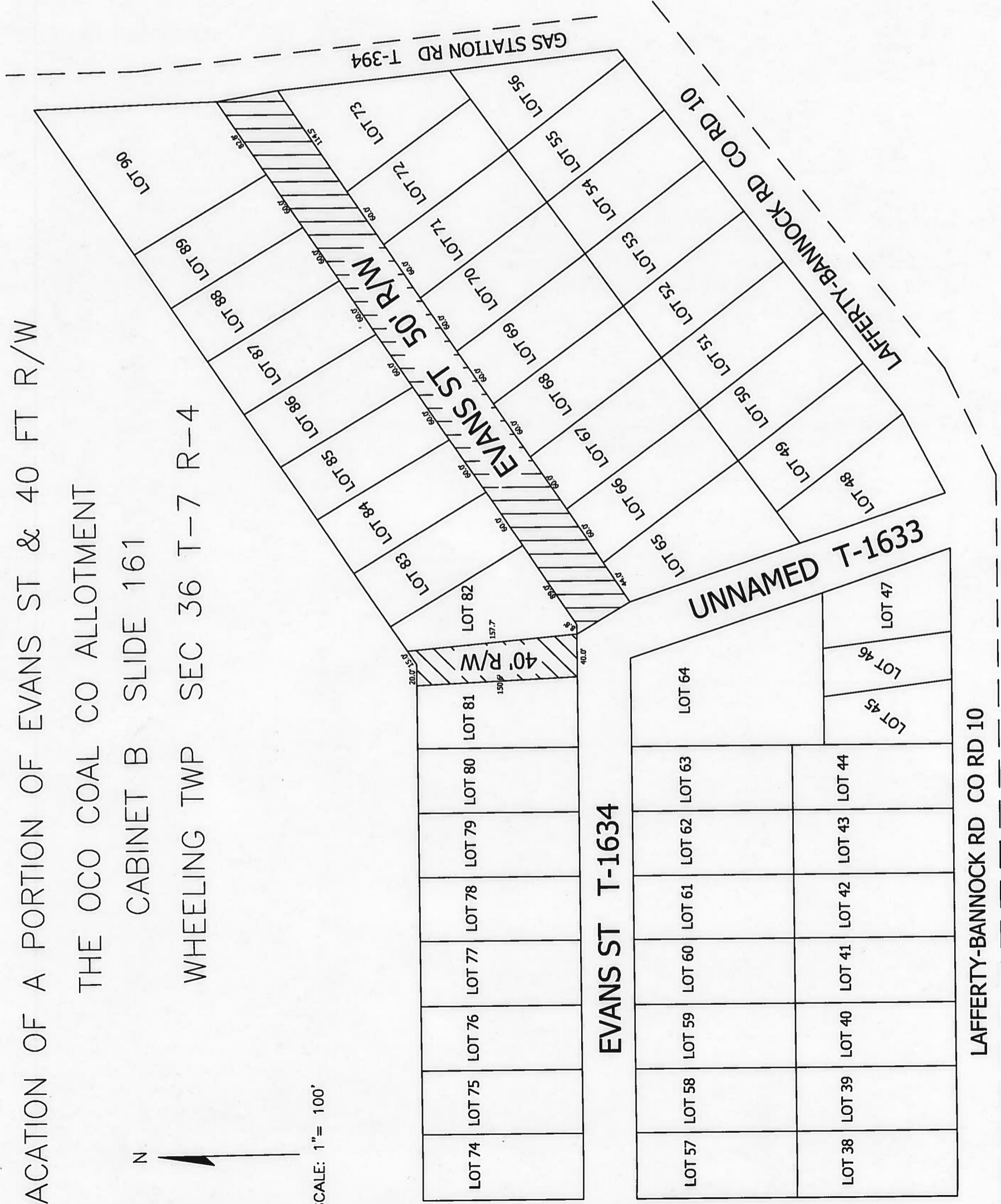
THE OCO COAL CO ALLOTMENT
